Kanuck Authentic 16

Those damn Kanucks could never come up with a drink this good! Canadian Club Whiskey is given a hit of Galliano L'Autentico with loads of Fresh Orange and Vanilla Syrup, that'll keep 'em North of the Border!

Thyme for a Lark 20

With Lark Pepperberry Vodka, Fresh Thyme, Cherry Tomatoes and Lemon Juice this will leave you with plenty of time for skylarking.

Passionate Fling 20

What's not to love about this drink, start with Super Premium 100% Agave 1800 Blanco Tequila spiked with Passoa, Cherry Heering & Benedictine then fruit it up with Passionfruit, Pineapple Juice & Lime with a sneak of Blackberry jam .

Trading Licks 19

To keep you licking your lips we've used a rinse of Pernod & added Trader's Gin with Pear Juice, Lemon Juice & Elderflower Syrup....mmm... tasty

The 7th Generation 15

A toast to the 7th generation of the Beam Family, Jim Beam Black is shaken with Licor 43 and a tittle of Apricot Brandy, this is then lifted with Pink Grapefruit Juice and a dollop of Apricot Jam.

SoCal Siesta 23

It never rains in Southern California when you mix 1800 Blanco Tequila with Pama Pomegranate Liqueur then sweetened up with Ginger & Coconut Sugar & Blood Orange Marmalade.

Donkey Punch 16

Careful this one might kick you in the Ass! Sauza Hornitos Tequila is muddled with Blackberry Liqueur, Lime & Apple Juice then kicked out with crushed Fresh Chilli.

Cold Blooded 15

You'll be anything but when you try this delicious combination of Tanqueray Gin & Dry Orange Liqueur hit with Chilli Syrup & Blood Orange Marmalade.

Grecian Honey 16

Think Baklava in a glass... Medos Honey Vodka is stirred up with Nocello Nut Liqueur & a sprinkle of Ginger & Coconut Sugar followed by a dusting of Cinnamon.



Cuban Curacafé 19

This Cuban Tonic is more than just a pick me up. Havana Anejo 7 is shaken with Amaro Montenegro Italian Liqueur, Licor 43 Vanilla Liqueur, Patron Citrónge Orange Liqueur & a shot of Espresso... Muchisimas Gracias!

The Ugly Duckling 22

It may not look pretty but tastes absolutely delicious as it slides down your throat. Gosling's Gold Rum is mixed with Wild Turkey American Honey Liqueur & Gabriel Boudier Pomes Apple Liqueur then spiked with Goldschlager Cinnamon Liqueur and spritzed up with Fresh Lime...as comforting as Apple Pie.

Old Barbados 24

Think Old Gold Chocolate with Fruit and booze it up..We blend crushed Muscatelle Grapes with Herradura Reposado Tequila & Mt Gay XO Rum then douse it With Mozart Dark Chocolate Liqueur & Blackberry Liqueur.

Trans-American 24

This one comes from all over the Americas! Havana Anejo 7 Rum from South America, Wild Turkey American Honey Liqueur from the US then a hit of Maple syrup & a rinse of Courvoisier for the French-Canadians!

YA Figgadeal Me? 16

A very original name using an ebonic colloquialism and stylistically lengthening the phrase "you feel me" whilst incorporating the word "fig" which dominates the flavour...? Tastes awesome hey! Shake up a hit of Jim Beam Small batch with Poire William Pear Liqueur, Fig Jam & Maple Syrup plus a squeeze of Fresh Lime.

The Whitey Ford 18

You'll never strike out with this combination of Beefeater Crown Jewel Gin, White Tea and Frozen Raspberries topped with Sparkling Wine.

Saggy Nuts 17

This one won't leave you hanging! All you need is Sagatiba Pura Cachaça with Nocello Nut Liqueur spritzed with Fresh Lime & dusted with Cinnamon

Killer Pair 25

If you want a killer pear then try this! Rinse some TMD Macadamia Liqueur then Don Julio Blanco Tequila is doused with Poire William Liqueur with a touch of Honey & Lemon to balance the flavours

Russian Vines 22

Though it may be a tad cold to grow Vines in mother Russia this would be a perfectly acceptable replacement. Ciroc Vodka and St Germain Elderflower Liqueur are muddled with White Grapes and a twist of lemon.

Blazed Mexican 22

No Mexican would mind being hauled over the coals for this sensation when Don Julio Blanco Tequila is Flambéed with Blackberry Liqueur & Fresh Blackberries!

Spicy Little Senorita 24

This naughty girl could get you into a lot of trouble! 1800 Blanco Tequila is spiced up with Grilled Capsicum, Chilli Syrup, Agave Nectar & a twist of Lime.

Talkin' Stout My Generations 28

You'll be foaming at the mouth for a taste of amazing drink. Sauza Tres Generationes Tequila is stirred up with White Curaçao, Galliano Ristretto Coffee Liqueur and a good dose of Stout then foamed up with a hit of Vanilla.

Knickers

A snappy variation of the Knickerbocker Classic, these are designed to get your knickers off!!

Raspberry Knickers 17

This Classic Original Appletons VX Rum is mixed with a splash of Cointreau, a squeeze of Lemon and a good dousing of Raspberry Syrup & Raspberry Purée that will get your knickers knotty.

Man Knickers 17

Not just for the Girls, let's see how this Man goes with Appleton's VX Rum, Cointreau & Lemon Juice with Mango Syrup and crushed Mango Puree.

Black Knickers 16

This oh-so-sexy combination of Appleton's VX. Rum with Cointreau, Lemon Juice added to Blackberry Jam & fresh Blackberries

Pash'n'Knickers 17

This will make you moan with passion...fruit, just add Appletons VX Rum to Cointreau & Lemon Juice with Passion fruit Syrup and Passionfruit Crush

Designed to warm the cockles of your palate these creative interpretations of a Classic Winter Warmer should keep even the Swine Flu at bay. A bit of direction for the first timers - We will give you a special spiced Tea like drink with your infusion shot on the side. It would be a good idea to wait for tea to cool a little before adding your shot so as not to lose all that lovely booze into vapour! Don't dismiss this as a weak drink either it will warm you inside and out!

Lazy Southerner 16

Starting with Earl Grey Tea we hit it up with Jim Beam Rye Bourbon & Dry Orange Liqueur then infuse with orange.

British Invasion 16

They would have won more wars with this blend of Earl Grey Tea sweetened with Honey then bombed with Mount Gay XO Rum and garnished with a Sceptre of Cinnamon.

Berry Green 16

Who says drinking isn't good for the liver. We start with Green Tea & Blackberries both packed with antioxidants then slip in some Plymouth Sloe Gin & a zest of Lemon.

Dominican Breakfast 18

A very easy drink to wake up to! Take fragrant White Tea & good serve of Matusalem Platino Premium White Rum with Raspberry Liqueur and Fresh Raspberries.

Tea-quila 18

A very refreshing blend of Peppermint Tea & freshly Grated Ginger with Herradura Silver Tequila and a caress of Agave Nectar.

Collins

A Collins is basically 'a fizz' in a taller glass. Created in the early 1800's after the introduction of charged (Soda) water, it consisted of a base alcohol with lemon juice and sugar syrup charged with soda water. The drink has spawned an entire family of variants such as

Tom Collins – Gin

John Collins - Vodka

Sandy Collins – Whisky

Pierre Collins - Brandy

Pedro Collins - Rum

Packed with flavour Tanqueray Gin is infused with Blood Orange Marmalade then spritzed with Lemon Juice & Soda

Blueberry & Vanilla Collins 18

This velvety smooth flavour is perfect to wile away an evening. Tanqueray Gin is infused with Crème de Cassis Liqueur, Vanilla Syrup and crushed Blueberries then spritzed with Lemon Juice & Soda.

Raspberry & Pomegranate Collins 19

Your tongue will tingle with this combination of Sweet & Tart Flavours! Tanqueray Gin is infused with Pomegranate Liqueur, Raspberry Syrup & spritzed with Lemon Juice & Soda

Lychee Collins 16

How can you improve one of the finest flavours that nature has to offer? A generous dose of Smirnoff Blue Vodka is infused with Lychee Syrup then spritzed with Lemon Juice & Soda

Mandarin & Chilli Collins 16

Blackberry Collins 16

Hibiscus & Coriander Collins 18

A generous dose of Tanqueray Gin is infused with crushed Coriander Stalks & Hibiscus Syrup & Orange Blossom Water and spritzed with Lemon Juice & Soda

Tikki Drinks

After Prohibition in America finished, two main Rivals emerged in the world of Tiki Rum or Tropical Island drinks, Trader Vic and Donn Beach. Beach's Bar in Hollywood "Don the Beachcomber's" was The pioneer, as it was his bar that inspired Victor Bergeron (Trader Vic) to change his bar in Oakland California to the same theme. These two Bars have created and inspired a myriad of drinks and we have included a few of our favourites...

Mai Tai 19

We believe you can tell how good a bar is By its Mai Tai and ours **KICKS ASS!**

Although it is wrongly reported in many a Drink List around the world, Trader Vic(Victor Bergeron) did not invent the Mai Tai. It was actually Ernest Raymond Beaumont-Gantt (Donn Beach) who invented the original in 1933. It has been widely bastardized but we at the Sceptre are staying true to the original and best Recipe.

Appletons VX Rum is shaken hard with Fresh Lime Juice, Grapefruit juice, Tikki Syrup, Cointreau, Angostura Bitters, Fresh Mint and a dash of Absinthe. Served tall over ice with extra Mint & a Pusser's Navy Rum float.

Rhubarb Daiquiri 16

A Sceptre inspiration of the Cuban Classic. Bacardi Carta Blanca shaken like your life depends on it with hand pressed lime juice and gorgeous rhubarb purée.

Grilled Colada 16

We bring the Classic 70's Kitschy Drink into the Naughties by Crushing Caramelised Pineapple with Appleton's VX Rum & Drambuie then a small dollop of Coconut Cream with a hint of Cinnamon & Cherry Syrup.

Zombie 16

Another twist to an old Classic Planter's Punch. Appletons VX Dark Rum, Havana Blanco White Rum & just a whisper of Apricot Brandy are shaken with Orange Juice, Pineapple Juice & Lime Juice then lifted with Orgeat Almond Syrup and a float of Bacardi 151 way overproof Rum!!

Pitchers

White Wine Sangria 35

Freshly chopped seasonal fruits loll around in chilled white wine, a dash of Brandy, Cointreau and sugar.

Pimm's No.2 Cup 40

Not the way your Aunt Gladys has it. Pimm's, Bacardi White Rum, Lemonade & Ginger Beer are mixed with freshly cut Cucumber, Lemon, Strawberries & Mint.

Lessons from the Past

Singapore Sling – 1915 Singapore 16

Created at the Long Bar in the Raffles Hotel, Singapore by bartender NgiamTong Boon. Tanqueray Gin, Fresh Lime Juice & Sugar poured over crushed ice, topped with Pineapple Juice & laced with Cherry Herring Liqueur, Cointreau and Benedictine.

Hemingway Daiquiri – 1920's Cuba 15

It was in the El Floridita Bar in Havana, Cuba, a favourite of the great man, that this awesome drink was born. Bacardi Carta Blanca mixed with maraschino, fresh lime & grapefruit juice.

The Godfrey – 1920's London 22

A large measure of Courvoisier VSOP Cognac & Fresh Blackberries accentuated with Crème de Mure & Grand Marnier with a splash of fresh Lemon Juice. Served on the rocks.

Bramble – 1990's London 16

One of only a few modern cocktails that can be labelled as a classic. London Cocktailian Dick Bradsell first came up with this mix of Tanqueray, fresh lemon juice & a lace of blackberry liqueur back in the early 90's. And thank God he did!

Pisco Sour – 1930's Peru 18

First seen on a list offered by The Morris Bar, a traditional bar located on Jiron de la Union in Lima, the Pisco sour blends Pisco with Lemon Juice & Sugar syrup and shaken with egg white.

Mint Julep – 19th Century, Kentucky 18

This Kentucky speciality is definitely the drink of the Bible Belt & you can't move for them come Derby day! We take Woodford Reserve Kentucky Bourbon, mix it with fresh mint leaves & sugar & serve as long & cold as a Winter morning.

Aviation – 1930's, London 20

This elegant blend of Aviation Gin, Maraska Maraschino Liqueur & Fresh Lemon Juice first appeared in the Savoy Cocktail Book in 1930. The Aviation really is style in a glass.

Pegu Club – 1930's, Burma 18

The men of the Pegu Club in 1930's Rangoon, Burma, liked nothing better than sipping on this sublime mix of Tanqueray Gin, Grand Marnier, Fresh Lime Juice & a dash of Bitters. Cool, Clean & Crisp.

Charlie Chaplin – 1930's, London 15

We have yet to confirm if the actor actually drank his "own" cocktail but it is a classic as it appears in The Old Waldorf-Astoria Bar Book from the 1930's. Since Chaplin did live into the 70's I'd have to think he had at least one sip of this Apricot Brandy and Plymouth Sloe Gin tippie. The cocktail is sweet, neat and it's hard to have just one. No wonder it's become a classic, just like its namesake

The Bronx 18

The Bronx, essentially a 'Perfect Martini' with a healthy supply of orange juice. It's a spectacular drink that was a hit before Prohibition. Created by Johnnie Solon at the Old Waldorf Astoria around the turn of the 20th century it combines Tanqueray Gin, Noilly Prat Dry Vermouth & Cinzano Rosso Vermouth with...Orange Juice

Clover Club – 1920's, Philadelphia 15

The signature cocktail of the Clover Club, a gentlemen's club in Philadelphia. A soft, yet strong mix of Tanqueray Gin, Grenadine, freshly squeezed Lemon & Egg White to produce a drink of outstanding quality.

Manhattan – 1870's, New York 16

Created by the unknown bartender at The Manhattan Club in 1874 for a party hosted by Jennie Churchill (mother of Winston) for Samuel Tilden, the newly elected Mayor of New York. The Sceptre Manhattans are served as they were 140 years ago, Canadian Club Whiskey, Italian Sweet Vermouth, Angostura Bitters, with a dash of Maraschino Syrup

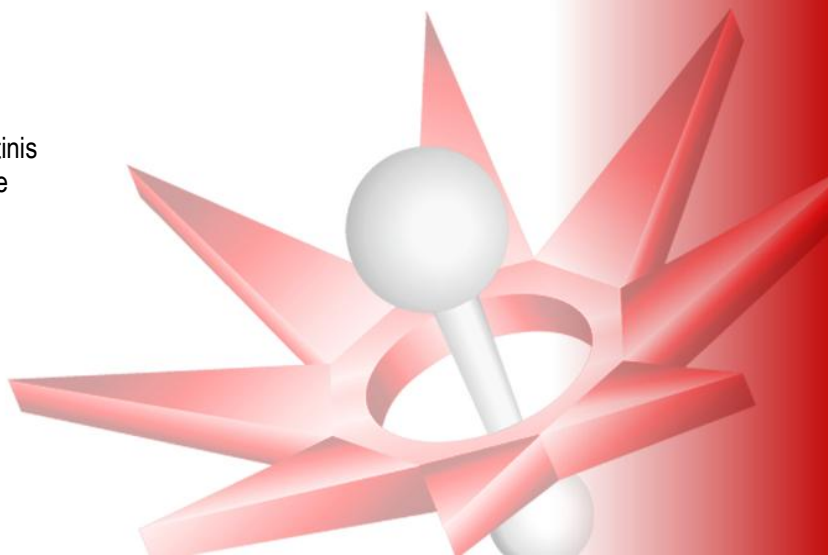

Other Classics

French 75 16

The story of how the French 75 became popular and received its name is said to be that it created by Harry MacElhone for returning WWI fighter pilots. It is named after an artillery gun called the French 75 which, like the drink, was known for its kick with its blend of Tanqueray Gin, Lemon Juice, a sprinkle of sugar & Sparkling White Wine

Metropolis 16

A deliciously lethal blend of Fraise de Bois Strawberry Liqueur, Smirnoff Blue Vodka & Sparkling White Wine a modern twist on a Champagne Cocktail which has been around since the dawn of man in various forms and will live on till the end of time..

Sours from 16

The Sour cocktail is the great grandfather of many modern cocktails, first described by "The Professor" Jerry Thomas in his 1862 book it is a balanced mix of sweet and tart components and contains a mixture of Base Liquor, Lemon Juice and a hit of sweetness. Try it with any of the 8 staples: bourbon, brandy, gin, rum, scotch, tequila, vodka, or whiskey.

Gibson from 16

Though the true origin of the Gibson is disputed it goes back to at least 1904 and is thought to be named after Charles Dana Gibson a very popular illustrator of the era. That aside it's a kick ass classic with your Choice of Gin or Vodka stirred with a vapour of Noilly Pratt Vermouth then bombed a few Cocktail Onions.

Perfect Manhattan 16

Much like the original Manahattan developed at the Manhattan Club in the early 1870s this variation has a 'perfect' balance of Dry & Sweet Vermouths with Canadian Club Whiskey.

Negroni 16

It's said that there are two drinks by which a bartender's skill can be judged. They are a Martini and a Negroni. The Negroni was created at the start of the 20th century for a Florentine aristocrat, Count Camillo Negroni. Bored with his usual cocktail, an Americano, the Count asked the bartender to perk it up a bit. The bartender added some gin and, from that day on, the Count drank only the Negroni cocktail. We use Tanqueray Gin then stir it up with Capari & Cinzano Rosso Vermouth served with a twist of Orange Zest.

Sidecar 26

The Sidecar was invented at a bar in Paris, during World War I, and was named after a good captain who was customarily driven to and from the little bistro in a motorcycle sidecar. Long overshadowed by the hussy cosmopolitan this speakeasy standard is making a comeback as subtle as its flavour. A classic Blend of Courvoisier VSOP Cognac is lovingly dressed with Cointreau & Lemon Juice.

Blood & Sand 15

While some cocktails are the result of sheer creativity, other recipes are inspired by specific events at a particular time. The Blood & Sand Cocktail for example, was created in 1922 for the premier of the film 'Blood and Sand', starring Rudolph Valentino, then the most successful actor in Hollywood. Comprising of Famous Grouse Scotch Whiskey, Cinzano Rosso Vermouth, Cherry Brandy Liqueur & Orange Juice.

Brandy Flip 16

The Flip began it's long history as a concoction of Rum, Beer & Sugar heated with a poker to warm up the old Salts of the Seas as early as 1695, over the years the beer was left out and so was the hot poker (luckily as it would be hard to keep an old poker hot behind the bar these days!) We prefer the modern recipe with St Agnes's finest shaken with Sugar & Egg Yolk then dusted with Nutmeg.

Gimlet 17

Although the exact history is a little uncertain, virtually everyone seems to agree that the British Royal Navy created the drink. The basic origin of this libation is thought to date from around 1876 when Britain mandated daily rations of lime juice to every sailor in its merchant fleet in an attempt to fight scurvy (a disease caused by Vitamin C deficiency) Get your Daily Dose of Vitamin C when chunks of Fresh Lime are shaken with Tanqueray Gin & Bickfords Lime Cordial.

Tom Collins 18

There's no person in cocktail history named Tom Collins. However, there was a John Collins. He was the headwaiter at a London hotel in the early 19th century, and the eponymous gin punch was originally named for him—though not created by him. According to cocktail historian and author David Wondrich, the recipe for a similar gin punch was circulating around London at the time. The name changed when the Old Tom brand of Gin was used to make the drink. We start with Old Tom Gin and shake it up with Lemon Juice, Sugar Syrup & spritz with Soda.

Moscow Mule 18

The history of the Moscow Mule goes back to 1941 and was invented by John G. Martin of Heublein, Inc., of East Coast spirits, and Jack Morgan, owner of the Cock 'n' Bull Tavern, a bar on the Sunset strip in Los Angeles. As the story goes, John had recently acquired the right to sell Smirnoff vodka in the US and Jack had a surplus of ginger beer at his establishment. Voila, they now have a new drink. Eventually John Martin used the Moscow Mule to help promote vodka to bars across the US and this helped fuel the mainstream acceptance of vodka as the preferred white spirit, replacing gin. We combine Smirnoff Blue Vodka with Cascade Ginger Beer and muddle in plenty of Fresh Lime.



Mojito 16

The mojito may have a trendy reputation outside of Cuba; however, its origins are anything but chic. A mojito-like beverage may have existed much earlier, perhaps as far back as the late 1500s. Legend has it that Richard Drake, an English pirate who made a career of terrorizing South America and the Caribbean concocted a beverage similar to the mojito by mixing Mt Gay Rum with Fresh Lime, Sugar & Mint then topping up with Soda.

Caipirinha 17

The word caipirinha means 'little countryside drink' in Portuguese. Although there's no definitive version of how the cocktail was invented, its story is bound up with that of cachaça, the spirit that Brazilians drink a staggering 200 million litres of every year. It seems likely that the caipirinha evolved as workers on Brazil's sugar cane plantations looked for a palatable way to drink the cachaça they were helping to produce.. Pronounced 'kai-purr-eeen-yuh' this drink is a mix of Sagatiba Pura Cachça, Muddled Fresh Lime & Sugar

Caipiroska 17

Quite literally a Caipirinha made with Vodka and quite simply because it just tastes so damn refreshing, to save you looking at the description above we'll let you know that is it a perfectly balanced mix of Smirnoff Blue Vodka, Muddled Fresh Limes & Sugar.

Lychee Bellini 14

The original Bellini was created in the famous Venetian establishment of Harry's Bar in 1948, Giuseppi Cipriani created this popular pick-me-up which was inspired by the 15th-century Venetian painter Giovanni Bellini. We have certainly not done him any disservice by adding a dash of Crème de Pêche & Paraiso Lychee Liqueur to Sparkling Wine

Cuba Libre 16

The Cuba Libre originated after the Spanish-American War in 1898 when American group of soldiers first mixed Coca Cola, Rum & a wedge of Lime to toast to the Freedom of Cuba! We use a double shot of fine Mt Gay Rum and serve it up tall

Cosmopolitan 16

Invented in 1985 by Cheryl Cook, a mixologist from Flo Rida, the Cosmopolitan is a rather new drink! It has spread throughout the US and the world gaining popularity in the 90s – especially after being frequently mentioned in Sex & the City. Shake up a swig of Smirnoff Blue vodka with Cointreau with a splash of Cranberry and a smallsqueeze of Fresh Lime.

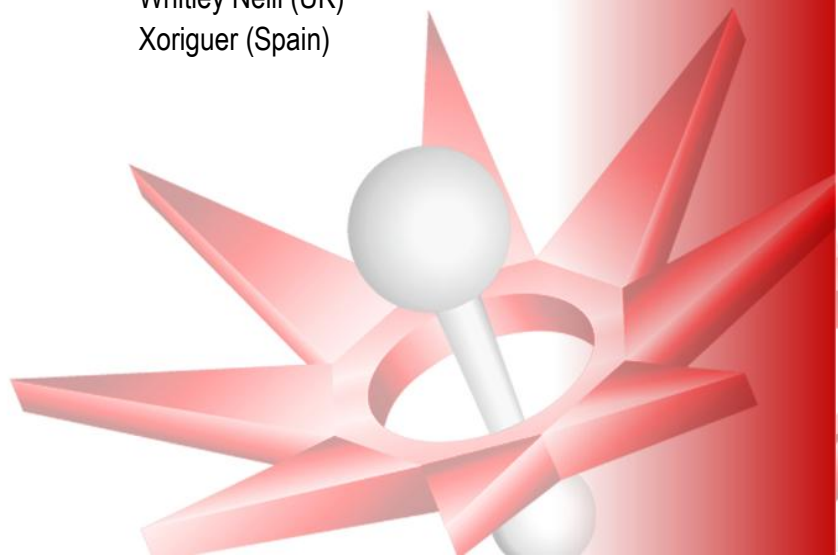

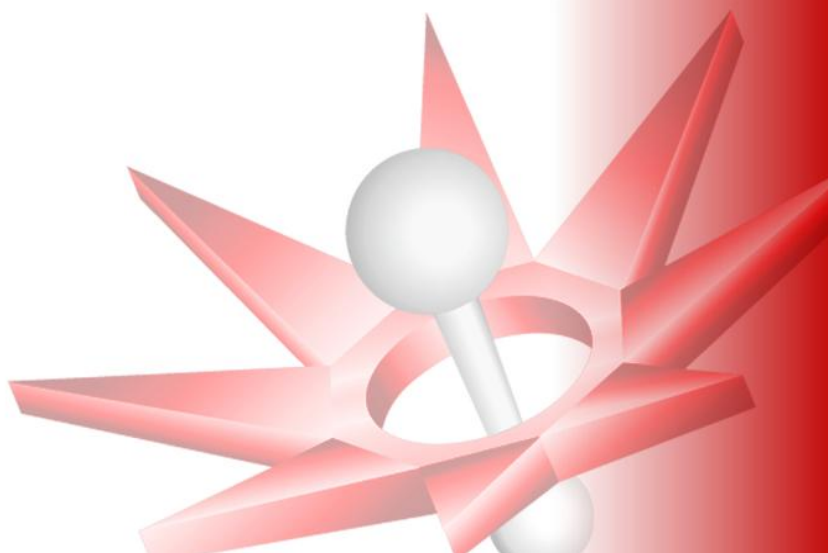

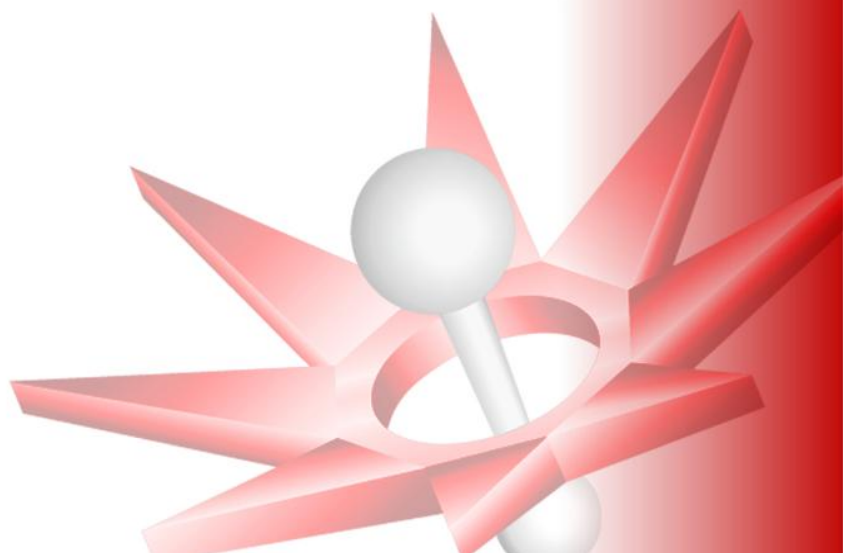
